

SQUASH

ENTRY FEES

- 1.1 The entry fee for the 2009/2010 ULU Inter-Collegiate League Season shall be determined by ULU and ratified by ICSC at the beginning of the academic year.

COMPETITION FORMAT

- 2.1 The League will abide by the Rules and Regulations of World Squash (www.worldsquash.org)
- 2.2 Fixtures are listed on a Monday, for completion prior to the following Monday, to allow maximum flexibility in acquiring court time.
 - 2.2.1 Clubs **MUST** change the dates on the FixturesLive website.
- 2.3 All teams will play each team in their respective divisions once over the course of the season.
- 2.4 Teams will be awarded 2 points for a win and no points for a loss.
- 2.5 If a match is forfeited by a team the other side will be awarded the League points plus a 5 - 0 walkover score, whilst a 2 point deduction will be applied to the offending team.
- 2.6 Leadership of the League Table will firstly be determined on points alone. If there is a tie on points, the result of the games between the teams concerned shall be the determining factor.
- 2.7 Where there is no other method of completing the entire league programme, a cup match may be played as a double header, representing both league and cup fixtures.

CONDUCT OF MATCHES

- 3.1 The type of ball used for league matches is optional.
- 3.2 Teams shall consist of 5 players normally of the same sex.
 - 3.2.1 Where an institution has insufficient female players to field a women's team during a given season, women may compete for the institution's men's team during that season on **application to ULU**.
- 3.3 Normal England Squash rules of play shall apply. A match shall consist of the best of 5 games. Each game is to 9 points
- 3.4 Teams must ensure that 2 courts and a minimum 2 hours of court time are booked for every fixture to ensure all games are completed.

MATCH OFFICIALS

- 4.1 Home teams should try to provide markers. If this is not possible, players from each side must take turns.

SUBMISSION OF RESULTS

- 5.1 **Home team** will be responsible for entering all of their ULU League and cup results into the on-line results system within 48hrs of each completed fixture. **Failure to do this will result in a 1 match penalty point deduction being imposed against the home team.**

CUP COMPETITIONS

- 6.1 There will be a separate Men's, Men's Reserves and Women's Cup competition run during the course of the season.
- 6.2 The men's competition shall be seeded, with the top four teams from the previous year's leagues being seeded to the semi finals. The men's reserves cup will be seeded, with the previous year's semi-finalists being the seeds.
- 6.3 A free draw shall take place for the women's competition.
- 6.4 Each match shall be played to a finish on that day.
