League Update & Season Overview

- Fixtures Live continues to reduce the amount of weekly admin required as long as people remember to text in their results !
- The weather had a major impact on the league fixtures for a second season running, and therefore the league completion date was extended to accommodate re-arranged fixtures – some matches were re-arranged more than once
- We only had one team withdrawing this season due to lack of players
- We welcome back to the Trysports league Bracknell Ladies 1s and Oxford Hawks Ladies 2s who were relegated from the South League
- But another successful season



League Update & Season Overview (continued)

- No of League Teams - 82 teams entered for 2009/10 season, although 1 team dropped out before the season began
 - 12 teams in Premier 1 & Premier 2
 - 12 teams in Divisions 1, 2, 3 & 4
 - 10 teams in Division 5



League Season 10/11

- No of League Teams - 85 teams entered for 2010/11 season
 - 13 teams in Premier 1
 - 12 teams in Premier 2
 - 12 teams in Division 1, 2, 3, 4 & 5
(the league is full up)

What's Changed

- The number of teams entering the league has increased by 4
- Premier 1 has increased from 12 teams to 13
- Division 5 has increased from (10) 9 teams to 12

We would like to welcome the new teams in Division 5 for this coming season and we wish you good luck in your first season



League Season 10/11 (continued)

- Reminders for all Clubs

- Three Counties Club Details – handbook information to be sent to Sue Yates asap
- Update fixtures live with details of your home matches i.e. venue & start time, as soon as you have the information ... and keep it maintained !
- Be familiar with the league rules (updated for the 10/11 season) – specifically rule 7 vii (re-arranged fixtures)
- Start to review your player registrations
- Remember to register your umpires
- For teams entering Division 5, please be aware of the ability of players and conscious of juniors playing for the opposition



League Season 10/11 (continued)

- Fixtures

For clarification:

- The fixtures are generated automatically from fixtureslive and have now been published on the website.
- Due to Premier 1 division having 13 teams, each week one team will have a bye (not shown on the sheets issued)
- Premier Division 1 matches shall not start after 3pm during Nov-Feb (change from 2.30pm)
- The league are happy for teams to switch their home and away fixture, if both teams are in agreement, usually to help pitch bookings. The league must be notified so that fixtureslive can be updated.
- The league are not intending to generate the fixtures manually !!
- The committee have already received 'comments' about the 10/11 fixtures, but they are what they are.



League Season 10/11 (continued)

- Benching Rule

The main and only purpose of this rule is to assist player development

- Someone who wishes to play at a higher level
- Will not form part of the 11 team squad and identified on the match form
- Can play up to a maximum of 20 minutes during their 2nd league game (captains responsibility to monitor)
- **Can not** come from a higher team to play in a lower team
- To administer this, umpires must receive the match forms showing team selection before the match commences



League Season 10/11 (continued)

- Moans & Groans

Can you please remind your captains ;

- hand the match forms showing team selection to the umpires before the match commences
- when players become team-bound that this is indicated on the match forms (TB)
- the home team text the results in
- the home team posts the match forms, to the league contact as indicated in the league handbook, as soon as possible after the fixture
- goal scorers to be maintained by the clubs

Running Your League

- How does it work?
 - Volunteer positions nobody gets paid
 - Management by Committee (mainly via e-mail, but some face to face meetings)
 - 2 Representatives from each county make decisions as required
 - Officers of the Committee i.e. Secretary, Treasurer, Player Registrations, can give opinions but do not vote
- What does it entail?
 - Checking team sheets each week
 - Maintaining league tables & web site
 - Registering players
 - Resolving disputes & giving advice
 - Improving league rules to keep making the league easier to run / fair to all
 - Providing League handbooks, fixtures & league packs
 - Maintaining the financial books
 - Liaising with SCHWL

Umpire Rules

- The county umpiring committees are responsible for the umpires who officiate over games in the Trysports league.
 - All umpiring issues post game are referred straight to the relevant County umpiring committee for their consideration
 - Where a registered & qualified umpire cannot be found for a game BUT an experienced/competent unqualified umpire is available
 - Contact the umpire rep for advice – they may be able to confirm that persons umpiring standard and give permission for them to officiate.
 - The more notice given the more likely a solution can be found!
